- B. Bidder has visited the Site, on uct of a thorough, alert visual examination of the Site and adjacent areas, and become familiar with and satisfied itself as to the general, local, and Site conditions that may affect cost, progress, an open of the Work.
- C. Bidder is familiar with and has satisfied itself as to all Laws and Regulations that may affect cost, progress, performance of the Work and including all American Iron and Steel requirements.
- D. Bidder has carefully studied all: (1) reports of explorations and tests of subsurface conditions at or adjacent to the Site and all drawings of physical conditions relating to existing surface or subsurface structures at the Site that have been identified in the Supplementary Conditions, especially with respect to Technical Data in such reports and drawings, and (2) reports and drawings relating to Hazardous Environmental Conditions, if any, at or adjacent to the Site that have been identified in the Supplementary Conditions, especially with respect to Technical Data in such reports and drawings.

- 5.02 The apparent Low Bidder is required to submit a detailed breakdown of his proposal within 48 hours after the bid opening which totals the lump sum amount above. This proposal should provide a detailed breakdown of the lump sum bid with unit pricing and thorough description of each component of the work. Any proposed deviations or exceptions from the specifications must be thoroughly described in the Bidder's proposal. Any special provisions must be thoroughly described in the Bidder's detailed proposal, if warranted.
- The prices shall include all labor, materials, (all convation is bid unclass fied and will not constitute any additional cost to OWNER if rock is encountered), byeing d, profit, incurance, and other costs necessary to cover the finished work of the several kinds called for.
- Bidder acknowledges that (1) the Lump rum Bio Price includes an account considered by Bidder to be adequate to cover Contractor's overhead and profit for each separately identified item, and (2) estimated quantities are not guaranteed, and are solely for the purpose of comparison of Bids, and final payment for all unit price Bid items will be based on actual quantities, and rimined as provided in the Contract Documents.




